 - Service Pack is about working and serving



What equipment will I need to be helpful and not be a burden?



Typical Contents

- Sturdy Clothes
 - Work gloves, work boots, muck boots, sturdy clothing (probably NOT denim!!!)
 - Safety glasses, hard hat, reflective vest, sunscreen, bug spray, headlamp, N95 mask
- Tools
 - Rope, multitool, shovel, mattock
- Food, water purification, first aid kit
 - **Scout 10-Essentials!**

Full Professional Level PPE
(Recommended for high-level work)

1. Hard hat
2. Hearing protection (earmuffs)
3. Safety goggles
4. Safety approved full face respirator
5. Disposable suit
6. Chemical resistant gloves
7. Rubber boots with safety treads
8. Disposable shoe covers

Minimal Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

9. Cap or hat with brim
10. Safety glasses or goggles
11. Safety goggles or glasses
12. Safety approved full face respirator
13. Disposable work clothes (long sleeve and pants)
14. Rubber gloves
15. Rubber boots (with treads or safety toe work shoes [optional])
