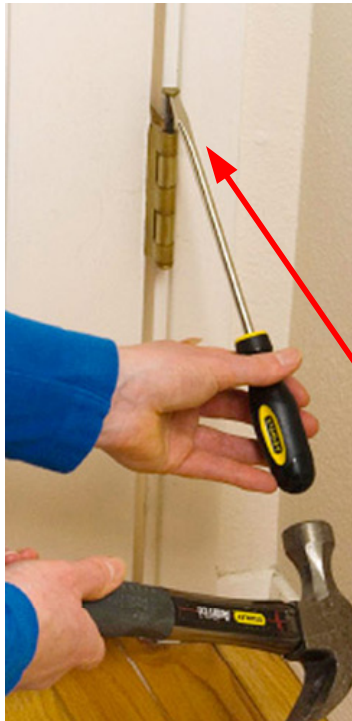
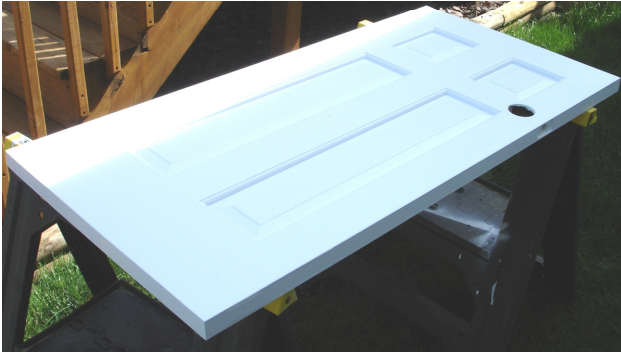


## Requirement 3b: Paint a Door

### Prepping the Door

- Doors are easiest to paint if they can be removed from frames and laid flat
- Doors can be removed by popping out the hinge pins with a hammer and screwdriver
- For best results, either remove all hardware or protect it with tape



Removing door hardware

Removing door hinges – get a helper to help hold the door while you pop out the hinge pins

### Painting the Door

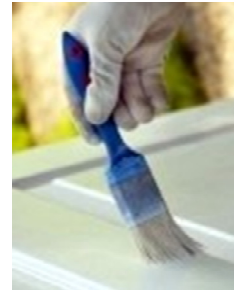
- Place a drop cloth on the floor where you will be working
- Lay the door flat on supports to elevate it off the ground
- Use a 4" fabric roller (foam does not work well) to paint most surfaces, use a paint tray to roll out excess paint before applying
- You may need a small trim brush to get into corners
- Paint the top and all four edges of the door
- Allow to dry overnight, then flip over and paint the other side of the door
- For best results, apply primer coat and then a color coat
