New Scout Start-up Packet – Start-up Essentials



- This start-up packet contains the following essentials:
 - Your Scouts BSA Handbook
 - Note: Troop 1028 (boys) and Troop 1029 (girls) have different Scouts BSA Handbooks
 - The girl's version has different pictures (with girls) and a slightly expanded Youth Protection / personal space section
 - Keep your Handbook in the provided Ziploc bag or get a cover
 - Green shoulder epaulets (1 pair)
 - Troop 1028 (boys) or 1029 (girls) numerals patch
 - Your Patrol patch
 - Typically a new Scout "transition" Patrol called a Phoenix Patrol where you stay for several months before moving to your permanent Patrol

 - You can use Scoutbook to mark off completed requirements,
 RSVP for upcoming events, see our calendar, give your Scout their own account, plus it has lots of other useful features
 - It's also easy to link to our calendars via your PC or phone!
